The Bank of America's Student Leaders Program helps provide inspiration and resource tools for today's young leaders. The program recognizes high school juniors and seniors who step outside of the classroom to contribute service in their own communities and beyond. Student Leaders® are awarded paid summer internships with local nonprofit organizations and participate in a Student Leadership Summit held in Washington, D.C.

Eligibility: Students who apply for the Student Leaders Program must:

1. Currently be a junior or senior in high school;
2. Be able to participate in an 8-week paid internship at a local nonprofit/charitable organization and work 35 hours a week;
3. Be legally authorized to work in the US without sponsorship through the end of September 2013;
4. Be able to participate in a week-long Student Leadership Summit in Washington, DC (July 8- July 13, 2013). (All expenses paid as part of the Student Leaders Program. This week will be part of your 8-week experience.);
5. Be a student in good standing at your school; and
6. Obtain a letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, or school administrator.
