College Horizons (CH) provides annual undergraduate admissions workshops for sophomores and juniors in high school looking to get insight and intensive preparation for applying to college. Native American, Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian high school students work with college admissions officers, college counselors, essay specialists, and other educators in a six-day college admissions workshop that focuses on understanding the college admissions/application process.

The individualized workshops help students:

- Select suitable colleges to research and apply to,
- Complete winning applications and write memorable essays (a skill that you can use throughout your life),
- Receive test-taking strategies and resources from experts on the ACT & SAT,
- Learn to navigate the financial aid process and complete scholarship searches,
- Develop relationships with admissions officers from our partner colleges,
- Receive tips and strategies on the application process,
- Get advice on how to succeed in college as a Native student,
- Go on a campus tour, attend a College Fair, and meet with 40 admissions,
- Meet and connect with 100 other Native youth from around the country,
- Travel on their own, visit a college campus, and experience life in the dorms, classrooms, computer labs, and in the athletic center.

There are 3000 colleges and universities available to choose from nationwide. College Horizons' goal is to help students find the schools and funding that will make their college experience meaningful and worthwhile.
