## Summer Camp Program


The Education Dept is proud to announce an exciting new program beginning May 2014. Tribal member and first generation students are eligible to attend up to 2 summer camps and receive financial assistance to help cover the cost of the programs.

Tribal member students are eligible for up to \$500.00 and first generation descent students are eligible for up to \$250.00 assistance.

Parents are responsible for making all arrangements and paying any fees over the amount paid by the Tribe. Travel costs will be paid by reimbursement only.

Applications for assistance must be submitted at least 4 weeks prior to the camp. Applications will be available at the Education Department or on the Tribes website at www.pci-nsn.gov

## Summer Camp Program Guidelines

The Summer Camp Program is being enacted to allow tribal students the opportunity to attend up to TWO (2) summer camps of their choice per year. Tribal member students are allotted up to \$500.00 and first generation students up to \$250.00. The type of camp attended is at the discretion of the parent and child. In order to take part in this program, the attached application should be completed by the parent and received by the Education Department at least 4 weeks prior to the start date of the camp.

## Information to consider:

The total allowable cost for this program is \$500.00 for Tribal members, and \$250.00 for first generation Indian descent. If the cost of the camp is more than the amount the Tribe will pay, the parent MUST pay their portion <u>prior</u> to the Tribe making payment.

If the child does not attend the camp for any reason, any refund of fees must be returned to the Tribe or that amount will be withheld from the per capita check of the parent.

The amounts available include travel costs, but on a reimbursement basis only. If the student must fly or take other public transportation, a receipt for the total fare will be required. Those traveling by personal vehicle can be reimbursed at the government per diem rate (currently .56 per mile) to the camp from their residence to drop off the child, and back again to pick up the child. No Tribal employee will be responsible for transporting children. Departmental transportation is only offered when the Education Department is the sponsor of the event.

A student may use these funds to attend up to two (2) camps per year.

We will not purchase or reimburse for clothing or special equipment.

The parent is responsible for making <u>all arrangements and completing all necessary paperwork.</u> The Education Department will only be responsible for payment.

Camps sponsored by the Tribe are not included in or eligible for this program.
